I am going to share with you a dream that the Lord gave to me 9/9/24.

My prayer is that you can glean wisdom from this .

My prayer is that if you can personally identify with anyone in this scenario that you Don't just stand idly by but you either began to REPENT for your actions, or began to pray for the person/persons you know enduring this right now.



The Lord showed me a couple who had gotten married, and the new wife felt as though she was married to the mother (yes even down to intimacy). I saw where the mother who was married herself had completely abandoned her own marriage.

I saw the new wife step into the bathroom and there were cords hanging from the ceiling near the tub. She told her new husband they couldn't live in this house "it dangerous "later that day the mom had come in and made repairs to the bathroom.

Every concern the wife had was now being "fixed" by the seamiling super mother in law. I saw the other sibling despise the new wife because now he had lost his brother. Or at least control over his brother, because now his brother was married.

The mom didn't mind her sons getting married, she just wanted to make sure that the wife was "her wife too"!

now after reading that you either think i have a vivid imagination, or you have seen a situation like this in your own life (or someone close to you).

What do you do if its you? Let's talk about it.



What do you think the other sibling was learning about marriage from the way the mother treated his brother? What kind of wife do you think the brother watching this play out would want (if at all). How do you think this made the husband feel? How does this affect the relationship between the father and his sons?

First I want to say that if you are newly married and you have people giving "advice " to you and your new husband. It's wise to qualify the person giving the advice.

Do they have the type of marriage that you desire?

See...

the mother in the above scenario completely abandons her own marriage to focus and essentially manipulate her son.

This happens often and for many different reasons, but I would like to submit one for your consideration.

Perhaps the mother found out that she couldn't control her husband so instead she moved on to controlling her sons.

Which is easier when children are young and they have not developed interest of their own. It becomes near impossible as they grow and really impossible as they find love outside of you. In a healthy relationship you want the best for your children and you let them go. That's not saying you don't still pray for them, and help them when they need you. But you definitely don't try to play God and begin to attempt to manipulate the situations and outcomes (witchcraft). 1 Samuel 15:23

The very fact that you have a desire to ruin happiness for another person is indicative of your own pain.

Perhaps you have experienced a breakdown in your marriage because of infidelity. And instead of forgiving you are now seeking to control ... cry out to the Lord .

Proverbs 18:22

"He who finds a [true and faithful] wife finds a good thing And obtains favor and approval from the Lord.

I don't think I need to elaborate much on the difference between a wife and a mother. It's admirable to desire to make your parents proud of you.

And the word even warns us to honor our parents.

honor: high respect great esteem

Control: determine the behavior or supervise the running of.



honor is NOT control and they very rarely exist together.

And let's not forget to mention the natural order of marriage.

If you find yourself in a situation like the one above this is out of order.

Honor God and acknowledge your need for him in your marriage and surely he will direct your path.

He will even teach you what honor looks like towards a mother who is trying to control you. I would be more afraid of dishonoring a woman the Lord has sent to be a blessing to you and to bring you favor(a wife)!

Then I would be a mother who is in rebellion against God.

Because a woman trying to control a man is out of order!

And surely anything that is out of order is rebellious.

Go back and read

1 Samuel 15:23 (read all of chapter 15)

to the wife, how did you get in the middle of this?

Did God lead you to this marriage?





If so, surely it's him who will sustain you.

Don't turn to any other source to help you with the problems you are facing in your marriage,

lest you end up in a worse situation (think of Adam and Eve).

if you got yourself into this mess (with a mama's boy) REPENT and the same God will

restore you.

Does the Lord not love a broken and contrite heart?

I have a lot of videos in my wifey series on my channel that will be helpful to you.

The effectual fervent prayers of the righteous accomplish much!

James 5:16 never leave prayer out of your marriage even in challenging seasons.

Contrite -feeling or expressing remorse

(notice the scripture says a broken and contrite heart ! Not a mouth ! So this is a heart posture, not just fancy words of im sorry! But it's the Lord who looks at the heart and determines if you are truly remorseful for the things that you have done.

I pray that this was a blessing to you. Don't just read this and walk away... pray! Ask the Lord is this you? Allow the Holy Spirit to shine a light on the areas you need healing. Pray for recovery of the things that you lost to unforgiveness. Pray for recovery of the things that you have lost because of your rebellion. Pray for the things that you have lost because of the pain you have been in because of what happened to you. Repent! For the role you played in causing pain to another. Ask God to teach you to love again, ask that your heart be softened and no longer Stoney. Ask that you are made courageous again and no longer afraid to trust.

Often these are then men laying on the couch that you are wiling to drag to work (until you have children) then you really start to see the problems. Other times they make all the money and they are very controlling themselves. They treat women like their mother treated them.

I am not telling you to do anything that the lord has not instructed you to do ...

I'm simply shining a light on the problem.

Pray for this mans restionation if this is your husband! And if it's not your husband you better make a wise choice!
